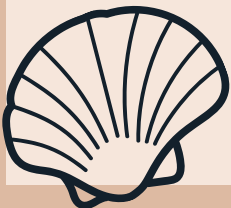

This month we will be watching two movies that, in their own very different ways, depict family drama. On August 17 at 7:00 PM we will meet, via Zoom, to discuss Yasujiro Ozu's masterpiece *Tokyo Story*. Ozu's post-war examination of a couple interacting with their adult children against the backdrop of a rapidly changing Japan is subtle and patient,

For our second family drama we will discuss John Krasinski's *A Quiet Place*. Starring Krasinski and Emily Blunt (Krasinski's spouse), this surprisingly heartfelt horror film explores a family dynamic against a backdrop of an apocalypse. Like Ozu, Krasinski succeeds by thoroughly exploring the relationships between parents and children while minimizing his use of certain filmmaking tools, in this case: sound and dialogue.
